and 2<sup>nd</sup> time to CODA at m. 29, play to m. 41, then  
skip to m. 56 and play to song end

My Savior Lives (WORD anthem) G:

VCVC+bridge(2X)+C+tag; G: begin on ms 9 and play  
through ms 58 as written, skip to ms 69 (2nd ending)  
and play through ms 82, then cut to ms 99 and play

101, (holding beat 1). (In the bass line of measure
